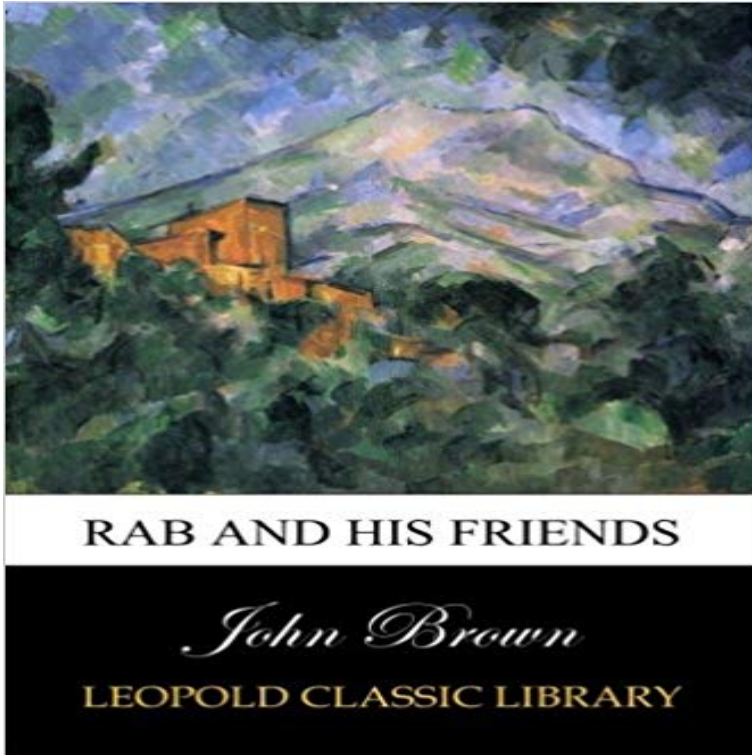


## Rab and His Friends
