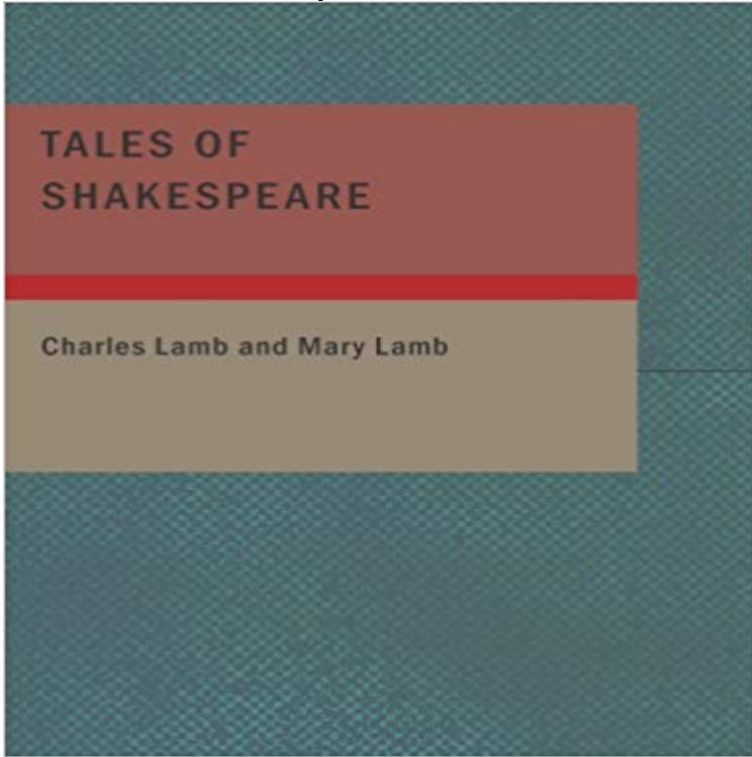


Tales of Shakespeare
