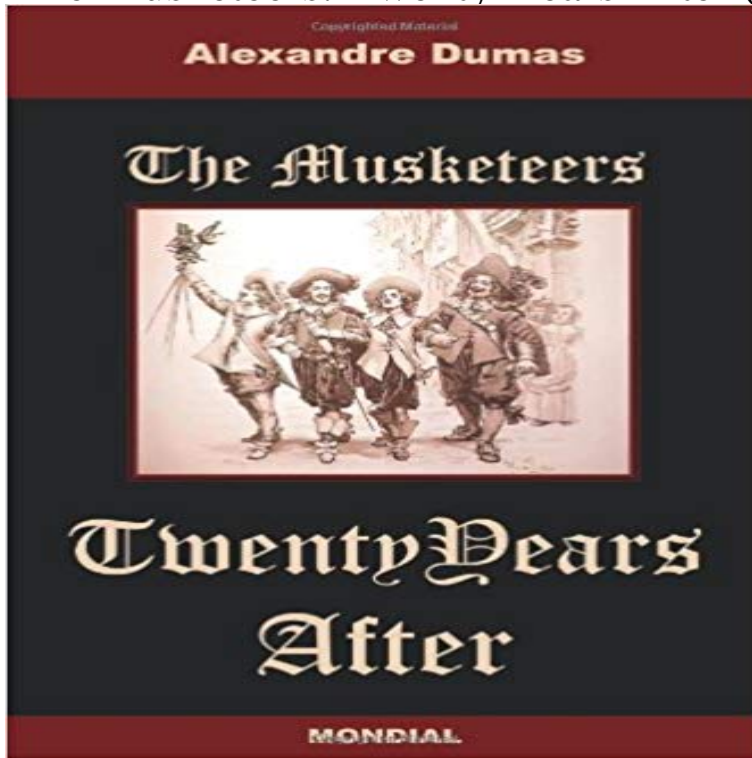


The Musketeers: Twenty Years After (French Classics)
